

How to make your own Time Capsule



A time capsule can be a fun way for families to preserve their memories. Uncovering your time capsule after a set period of time, i.e. 1 year, 5 years or 10 years, this will be a thrill for everyone!

Supplies needed:

Cookie Tin/Coffee Tin/Tin can with an air tight seal
Ziploc- - squeeze out all the air
Paper
Tape

Items to Include:

Report Cards
Pictures from Vacations or fun things you did during the year
Important events –
Newspaper or magazine articles
Predictions for the future
Awards
Letters to your future self
A description of yourself
A letter describing your past year
Postage stamp
Grocery bill (so you can compare prices in the future)
CD's
Ticket stubs from concerts you went to the past year

You can bury your time capsule somewhere in your yard or somewhere in the house. If you chose to bury it in the house, make sure it isn't someplace you access often, then you won't be tempted to open it. Try the attic or in the basement. Make a treasure map of where you hide the capsule so you will be able to find it in the future.
